

Explanation of infertility benefits for NewYork-Presbyterian POS plan

Infertility benefits coverage

Outpatient comprehensive infertility services	\$35 then the plan pays 100% (of the balance of the negotiated charge) per visit; no deductible applies	70% (of the recognized charge) per visit
Outpatient ART services including IVF**	80% (of the negotiated charge) per visit	70% (of the recognized charge) per visit
Maximum per lifetime***	\$30,000	Not covered

^{*}Please refer to pharmacy benefits documents for separate coverage (not counted toward \$30,000 maximum).

^{***}As used for this benefit, "lifetime" is defined to include covered benefits paid under an NYP-sponsored plan to the same individual. The individual lifetime maximum prior to 1/1/2021 was \$15,000. Individuals who met the \$15,000 lifetime maximum have access to an additional \$15,000 benefit effective 1/1/2021.
